Great Britain Wheelchair Rugby (GBWR) is looking to build on the success of the last four years where, supported by Sport England, the Lottery and sponsors it is now providing wheelchair rugby to a wide range of individuals and organisations. GBWR now wishes to build on this success and having achieved further investment from Sport England we are looking to recruit a Projects Officer – Variant, to lead on the development and delivery of the new variant programme. The successful candidate will join an active, passionate team with a strong work ethic and a commitment to building rich wheelchair rugby communities.

Great Britain Wheelchair Rugby (GBWR) is the National Governing Body (NGB) for the sport of wheelchair rugby in England, Scotland and Wales. In addition to the Great Britain team we have 22 teams across the country and we deliver programmes in Spinal Injury Units, military rehabilitation centres and as part of a growing number of charitable foundations such as those of Saracens, Harlequins and Exeter premiership rugby clubs; we also have a national youth programme. We work with a number of partners and have just successfully been awarded Sport England funding to further deliver our exciting programme of activities.

The ideal candidate will have considerable experience developing and delivering participation initiatives across disability sports. They will have a background in disability sport, ideally wheelchair rugby, with an understanding of classification and sports development. It is also assumed that the individual would be able to demonstrate strong interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to influence at all levels.

This is a permanent position based on a 18.5 hour week (part-time) with a salary of £25k pro-rata.
