Course Structure and Requirements

1st4sport Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Wheelchair Rugby (QCF) is a 4 day course and covers the following topic areas:

the learning process, role & responsibilities, coaching process, planning coaching sessions, coaching younger players, coaching different impairment groups, nutrition & drug awareness, fitness, delivering effective practice, practical delivery & assessment.

Learners will be required to take an active part of all 4 days of the course.

Workbooks for the coaching course will be provided in electronic and written forms, but all work will be submitted electronically. Learners will have access to the printed copies, but it is beneficial to have access to the electronic copy via a tablet or laptop during the course. Learners will also need access to a Rugby Chair for the course, please notify GBWR if you do not have a rugby chair to use.

Days 1 & 2 of the course are predominantly theory based and will take place in a classroom. There are also 2 practical afternoon sessions during this part of the course; learners are required to take an active part in these sessions, as players and coaches.

Learners will be required to complete 4 written tasks in their own time between the two course weekends. Learners will also be required to plan, document and deliver 4 linked progressive, coaching sessions in a club environment, between the two course weekends.

Days 3 & 4 of the course are completely practical based, where learners will be required to coach as well as be players for other candidates coaching sessions. Learners will be required to deliver pre-planned coaching sessions and be assessed during this part of the course.

A £50 deposit will be required to reserve a place and full payment will be required one month prior to the course start date.

Pre-Requisites

Learners will be at least 18 years of age.

Learners will have a 1st4Sport level 2 qualification in an invasion game and have attended the GBWR Safe Session training course or:

- hold a Level 1 Activator (Wheelchair Rugby) qualification, or

1st4sport Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Wheelchair Rugby (QCF)

- have at least 2 years wheelchair rugby playing experience, in a recognised GBWR club, or
- be actively and regularly volunteering in wheelchair rugby in a coaching/coach assisting capacity, for at least two years in a recognised GBWR club

Learners will be: able to communicate effectively in English

Learners will be appropriately identified

Candidates are required to have a current SportsCoach UK Safeguarding certificate or will be required to attend the SportsCoach UK Safeguarding workshop, before Level 2 certification.
