TOURNAMENT RULES

SUPER SERIES RESULTS / POINTS RECORDING

This document outlines how the Super Series operates across Divisions 1, 2 & 3. For general detail on the recording of results, please see the [GBWR Tournament Rules](#).

Divisions 1 & 2

The 8 teams in both Divisions 1 & 2 are divided into 2 pools of 4 teams.

These 4 teams play each other and are awarded 3 points for a win and 1 point for a loss. These points determine their position within the pool.

The 2 pools then play cross over games based on their finishing position, so the winner of Pool A will play the 2nd place team from Pool B and the winner from Pool B will play the 2nd place team from Pool A etc. The result of these games determines the final placing games.

These final games will then decide the placings from 1st to 8th. League points are then awarded on the following basis;

Final placings	League points
1 st	10
2 nd	8
3 rd	6
4 th	5
5 th	4
6 th	3
7 th	2
8 th	1

Division 3

The 4 teams in Division 3 all play each other once at each event and points are awarded on the basis of 3 points for a win and 1 point for a loss. These points determine their position within the league table.
