Being an international wheelchair rugby coach: experiences of the Paralympics'

Paul Shaw has been the head coach of the GB squad since 2013, taking the team to the Rio 2016 Paralympic Games, 2 World Championships and 4 European Championships, winning 3, with the team currently ranked 4th in the world.

In his playing career he first represented GB in 1995 at the World Championships in Switzerland. His career continued until 2008, and within this time Paul competed in 4 Europeans Championships, 4 World Championships and 3 Paralympic Games. After Paul retired from playing, he went on to become the head coach at West Coast Crash.
