ANNUAL OVERVIEW OF ANTI-DOPING ACTIVITY APRIL 2021 - MARCH 2022

Clean Sport Education

The GBWR Anti-Doping Strategy and Clean Sport implementation plan has been drafted and both are under review by the UKAD education team.

A total of 14 athletes, 3 coaches and 7 athlete support personnel received Anti-doping education including the Clean Games workshop prior to attending the Tokyo 2020 Games, which were held in August 2021.

A further 5 athletes and 3 athlete support personnel received education prior to attending the WWR European Championships, in February 2022.

GBWR's Anti-doping lead has successfully completed their UKAD educator training, so will now facilitate the delivery of GBWR's clean sport education.

Clean Sport Education workshops have been scheduled for delivery across the performance pathway, these will commence from April 2022.

Communications

GBWR's Anti-doping website pages have been updated to include the 2021 rules and further information as required by the UKAD assurance framework. An agreed increase in Clean Sport posts on GBWR's social media channels is regularly scheduled, to ensure latest clean sport news and anti-doping updates.

Board Engagement

Anti-doping was discussed by GBWR's Board of Trustees initially in September 2021. In December 2021's board meeting, a trustee was designated to lead on Anti-doping. An update on the Assurance Framework compliance progress was provided to the GBWR's Board of Trustees in March 2022, where the board also confirmed the adoption of the UK Anti-doping rules.

Testing

From the GBWR International Athletes eligible for Testing. We have completed:

- 15 Out of competition tests, by UKAD
- 6 In competition tests, at Tokyo Paralympics and WWR European Championships
