

GREAT BRITAIN WHEELCHAIR RUGBY ANNUAL OVERVIEW OF ANTI-DOPING ACTIVITY APRIL 2022 - MARCH 2023

Clean Sport Education

The GBWR Anti-Doping Strategy and Clean Sport implementation plan was approved by UKAD and GBWR received confirmation of compliance with the UK National Anti-Doping policy in July 2022.

The UKAD 2023 annual submission was completed and accepted in April 2023, currently GBWR are on track with their education plan as detailed in the framework.

Within the year a total of 16 athletes, 6 coaches and 8 athlete support personnel received Anti-doping education during this year. They have all also completed the relevant online training to their roles.

- Complete Clean + (Athletes)
- Coach Clean (Coaches)
- Introduction to Clean Sport (Athlete support personnel)

GBWR's Anti-doping lead Lee Stutely facilitates the delivery of GBWR's clean sport education. Inclusive of Clean Sport Education workshops which are scheduled for delivery across the performance pathway, at suitable times. This is also included in the Talent curriculum.

Communications

GBWR's Anti-doping website pages remains updated with the latest information. GBWR's social media plan has Clean Sport posts scheduled, so some communication is posted every 3 months.

GBWR supported UKAD 2022 Clean sport week by creating video posts by GB athletes to support the campaign which were shared on our communication platforms.

The annual updated Prohibited List 2023 was shared with all Performance athletes and staff in December 2022.

Board Engagement

Anti-doping was discussed by GBWR's Board of Trustees in June 2022, where approval for amendment to the membership rules to fulfil UKAD requirements was discussed and agreed. GBWR's Chairman, CEO and board lead on Anti-Doping all updated on GBWR's compliance and annual submissions with UKAD. GBWR Antidoping updates are included at all BOT meetings.

Testing

From the GBWR International Athletes eligible for Testing. In the period April 2022 – Dec 2022. We have completed:

- 21 Out of competition tests, by UKAD
- 2 In competition tests, at the World Championships, Denmark 2022
